COUNCIL MEMBER CHIN HOSTS SEGMENT ON AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR SENIORS

Special airing on Manhattan Neighborhood Network focuses on desperate need for growing population of elderly New Yorkers

CITY HALL - Council Member Margaret Chin appeared as host of "Represent NYC," a show that aired this week on the Manhattan Neighborhood Network, to talk about the urgent need for affordable housing for seniors in New York City.

Joining Council Member Chin on the 28-minute program is Bobbie Sackman, director of public policy at LiveOn NY, and Susan Wright, an expert on senior housing design and a member of the American Institute of Architects.

The episode appeared as Council Member Chin prepared to testify this week at an LMDC hearing regarding vital funding for an affordable senior housing project at 21 Spring St. in Little Italy. The proposed project, located on a city-owned site, is planned to be the future home of up to 100 units of affordable housing, which Council Member Chin and the city are committed to setting aside for our seniors.

The hearing will take place TODAY, Sept. 17 at 4:30 p.m. at Fiterman Hall/BMCC, 245 Greenwich St., 13th Floor.
